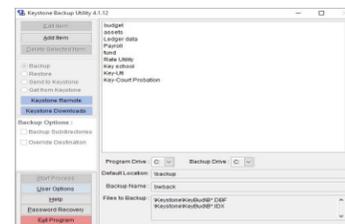

## Key-Data Backup Utility Provides Button Access to Keystone Downloads and Keystone Remote

Key-Data Backup Utility is provided at no charge to each of our customers for the purpose of procedural backups. It is not intended to replace your full system tape backup or cloud backups. It is designed to copy only data of each program as selected to protect your work at crucial times in your accounting procedures.

In the spirit of streamlining your desk top, we have added two new buttons to Key-Data v4.1.12. The "Keystone Remote" button will access Team Viewer to allow us to assist you online. The "Keystone Downloads" button will take you to our download web address to get program updates and enhancement information.

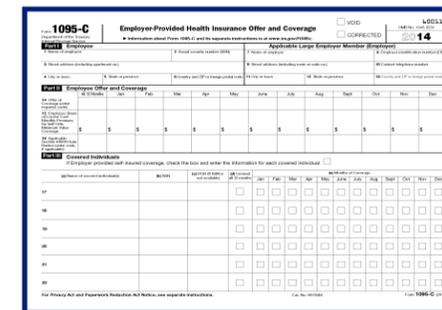


### Sue Taylor Retires from Boyce After 23 Years of Service

## Affordable Care Act Coverage Reporting Due January 2016

Affordable Care Act (ACA) reporting for 2015 is due in January 2016. Key-Payroll and Key-Payroll for Schools have the added features of tracking the required information and creating form 1095-C for Self-Insured Applicable Large Employers (ALE).



In your initial setup, you will mark your qualified health coverage deductions as ACA deductions. Two new tabs have been added to the employee master file, "ACA Coverage" and "Dependents". Each will track the information needed to create the 1095-C form. The new HELP section will walk you through the initial setup for employees and dependents. The required code descriptions for Line 14 (Offer of Coverage) and Line 16 (498H Safe Harbor) are also found in the new HELP section. Line 15 (Lowest Cost Monthly Premium) will come from your own premium list. Initial setup can also be performed through the EDIT WIZARD. Each method allows you to add info from January 1, 2015 to current month.



After initial setup, there is a monthly procedure for updating this information for future months, all gathered for the purpose of creating the 1095-C. Part of your year-end procedure will now include creating and printing the 1095-C forms for your employees and the 1094-C for submission to the proper entities. The 1095-C is due at the same time as W-2s.

## Key-Payroll Update is More Than Federal Law Changes

In addition to adding ACA compliance changes (see article pg. 1), several other enhancements have been added to the new Key-Payroll release:



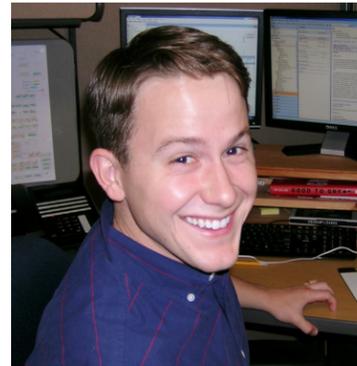
- The employee master file now has an attachment button. You can attach CDL license copies, W-4 and WH-4 and other required paperwork directly to your employee's master file.
- A new report has been added to the EDDA setup to verify Employee number, name, and email address.
- Regular Teacher Contracts have been updated to the 2015 version.
- Ohio tax tables have been updated.
- INPRS Transaction report can now be printed by retirement number.
- A new tab on the master file allows for CEU (Continuing Education Units) tracking.
- EDDA (Email Direct Deposit Advices) now has the option to email the advices after payroll is complete as well as maintaining the option to automatically send.
- We have also added a "Lose It" feature to PTO Group changes.

**Just a Reminder...** Beginning with effective date January 1, 2016, all maintenance renewals can be executed with a single acceptance form. Sign, date and stuff in the envelope with your remittance. Throughout 2015 new Boyce Systems Maintenance Terms & Conditions master agreements were sent with this procedure in mind. Each of you should now have (or will shortly have) a complete 2015 agreement to keep on file. Subsequent acceptance forms incorporate the language of the original and can be attached as an addendum each year. Please let us know if you have any questions.

## Key-Fund Continues to Expand

Key-Fund gets better every year. Some of the enhancements you will see in the released version include: added the ability to print signatures on APVs; added grouping option to all Chart of Accounts reports; took credit memo out of the tab order on APVs to speed up entry; added ability to search by Total Amount instead of Line Item Amount in the Lookup area, Purchase Order area and Expended area; added a Previous and Next button to the Fund, Appropriation and Revenue areas; added the ability to liquidate invoices in AR Invoice; added the ability to delete old annual

reports during year-end rollover; took away the ability to add a duplicate account to the annual report.

*Future Development includes:* APV Line Item Vendor Tracking for use with Procurement Cards or Credit Cards; adding the ability to import a file from the Procurement Vendor to directly create the APV; adding the ability to assign default appropriation accounts to vendor master files for quick searches; adding the ability to have multiple bank deposits per day in Bank Reconciliation.

## Microsoft Windows 10© Released

Microsoft has released their new Windows 10© operating system update. We have been testing here with the Keystone products and have so far not had any difficulties. Some of our customers have updated to Windows 10© and are using it successfully. If you do upgrade and experience any problems, please let us know immediately. And, as always, be sure to backup before attempting the installation.
